Each year, thousands of Irish Americans gather on St. Patrick's Day to share a "traditional" meal of corned beef and cabbage. Though cabbage has long been an Irish food, corned beef only began to be associated with St. Patrick's Day at the turn of the century. Celebrations generally involve public parades and festivals, Irish traditional music (ceilithe), and the wearing of green attire or shamrocks. St. Patrick's Day parades began in North America in the 18th century but did not spread to Ireland until the 20th century. The participants generally include marching bands, the military, fire brigades, cultural organizations, charitable organizations, youth groups and so on.
